# Yorkshire folk rejoice...the 10p starter!

HERE'S a mouthwatering opportunity for cash-conscious Tykes with a liking for good grub.

Ten restaurants and bars across the city have announced they will be selling starters for 10p on Saturday, May 8.

The promotion has been arranged as part of the countdown to this summer's Leeds Loves Food festival.

Participating venues include Casa Mia Millennium in the city centre and The Angel's Share in Chapel Allerton.

Cath Follin, the council's city centre manager, said: "We want people to get into the Leeds Loves Food spirit early.

"This is a great way of promoting the restaurants involved and helping people enjoy good food without having to spend a fortune."

Taking place for the second year in a row, Leeds Loves Food will run from July 1 to 4.

Full details of the programme are not being announced until 'Starter for 10p' day.

## Masterclass

Last year's attractions, though, included a food fete in the Victoria Quarter shopping arcades, a cocktail-making masterclass at the Reform bar and a cookery demo by Yorkshire-born TV chef James Martin.

The event is being organised by Marketing Leeds and Leeds City Council in partnership with Leeds Restaurant Association.

People wanting to claim a cut-price starter on May 8 will need to have a special voucher with them that can be printed off from the [www.leedslovesfood.com](http://www.leedslovesfood.com) website.

Each restaurant will be selling one dish for 10p on the day.

Their differing terms and conditions can also be viewed on the festival website.

The full list of venues taking part in the promotion is: The Angel's Share, Casa Mia Grande, The Mustard Pot (all Chapel Allerton); Bretts Fish Restaurant (Headingley); Casa Mia Millennium, Lounge Bar and Grill, Pomegranate Organics etc, Neon Cactus, Normans (all city centre); Thorpe Park Hotel and Spa.
